

Award-winning Photographer Teresa Grove to Showcase the “Wonder and Wild” of the Kansas Prairie at New Manhattan Art Exhibit

Manhattan, KS—Lawrence-based photographer Teresa Grove, who has been named one of the Kansas Professional Photographers Association’s Top Ten photographers of the year, will be one of two featured artists in a new exhibit at Manhattan’s SNW Gallery this month. The exhibit, titled “Wonder and Wild”, will highlight scenes from the Kansas Flint Hills, with special emphasis on its herds of bison and longhorn cattle. Grove will be joined in the exhibit by painting artist Nathan Novack. The exhibit runs from November 9th-December 30th.

Grove’s iconic photography, which lives in private and corporate collections across the country, highlights the beauty and majesty of the state she calls home.

“So much of photographing the prairie is having the patience to wait for that special moment of light or the expression of a wild animal, and then capturing it in my camera’s lens in a fleeting second before it’s gone,” Grove said. “My hope is for the viewer to share in this experience.”
