To build a community for printmakers, and support the production and tradition of Fine Art Printmaking in the Kansas City region, Greenhouse Print Space presents Print Club.

Kansas City, MO — Greenhouse Print Space (GPS) will host the second edition of Print Club, a relaxed, informal social gathering, centered around traditional and contemporary print arts, Tuesday March 25th.

“When I graduated from The University Of Kansas with my BFA in Printmaking, I knew I lost something. Outside of academia, finding reliable access to traditional printmaking facilities was, to put it lightly, difficult.” Thayer says, recounting the impetus for opening GPS. “Eventually, I was able to regain access to presses as an employee of The Lawrence Lithography Workshop. But there was still something missing; it took me years to figure out that I needed the community that grew out of the printshop just as much as I needed the presses.”

To build community, Thayer is opening up GPS on the last Tuesday of every month for Print Club, an informal meeting of artists, designers, professionals and amateurs, who are interested in print and printmaking, and who wish to connect with other print people.

Located in the basement of the Hobbs Building in the West Bottoms, Greenhouse Print Space houses, and provides public access to, the largest selection of printmaking presses, equipment, tools, and workspace -outside of an academic setting- within a 5 state radius of Kansas City. Thayer continues: “Process- based arts, like printmaking and ceramics, require and nurture not just sharing of space and equipment, but sharing of ideas, processes, and techniques. KC is already a big ceramics city; I think, with our midwest work ethic, we can build an equally great culture and practice of print here too.”

The second meeting of Print Club will be Tuesday March 25th, from 6-11 PM at Greenhouse Print Space, 1427 w 9th st, KCMO 64101. The (optional) homework for this meeting is: design a Shirt for Print Club.
